parents and carers, removing the need to use disposable cups that are non-recyclable and damage the environment.

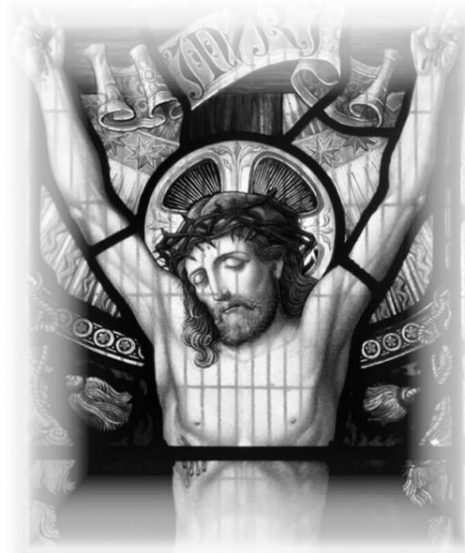
