Bitesize information: What goes on around us?

A very quick tour this week.

We, St James' Church, are the **Parish** Church of West End. We form a **Cluster** with our neighbouring parishes, St John's Hedge End and St Lukes' Hedge End. This in turn is one of four Clusters of churches within the **Eastleigh Deanery**. Eastleigh Deanery is one of six deaneries within the **Archdeaconry of Bournemouth**. Archdeaconry of Bournemouth, together with the Archdeaconry of Winchester, are the two parts of the **Diocese of Winchester**. Our diocese is one of 30 within the **Province of Canterbury**. And the Province of Canterbury and Province of York together constitute the **Church of England**.
