CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL Please note **Anyone on last year's roll MUST re-apply**. 2019 is the year the Church compiles a new Electoral Roll which will stand for the next six years. This means that no-one is automatically put on to the new roll. Who is eligible to go on the roll? Anyone who lives in the Ecclesiastical Parish of West End OR anyone living outside the parish who regularly attends the parish church. Only persons on the Electoral Roll have the right to attend Annual meeting where they can vote, having been on roll for six months, take positions of responsibility within the Church, i.e. become a side's person, a member of the PCC or represent the Parish at Deanery Synod. If you wish to go on the Electoral Roll please take a form from the back of Church and return the completed form to Electoral Roll Officer Margaret Baker. Forms are available at the back of church.

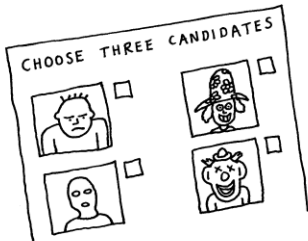

REASONS TO JOIN IT

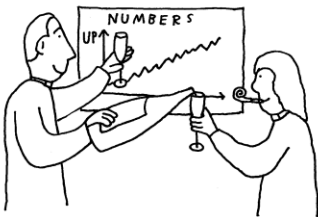

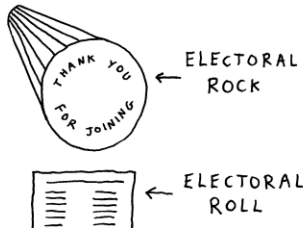
- ② YOU CAN PLAY A FULL PART IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH
